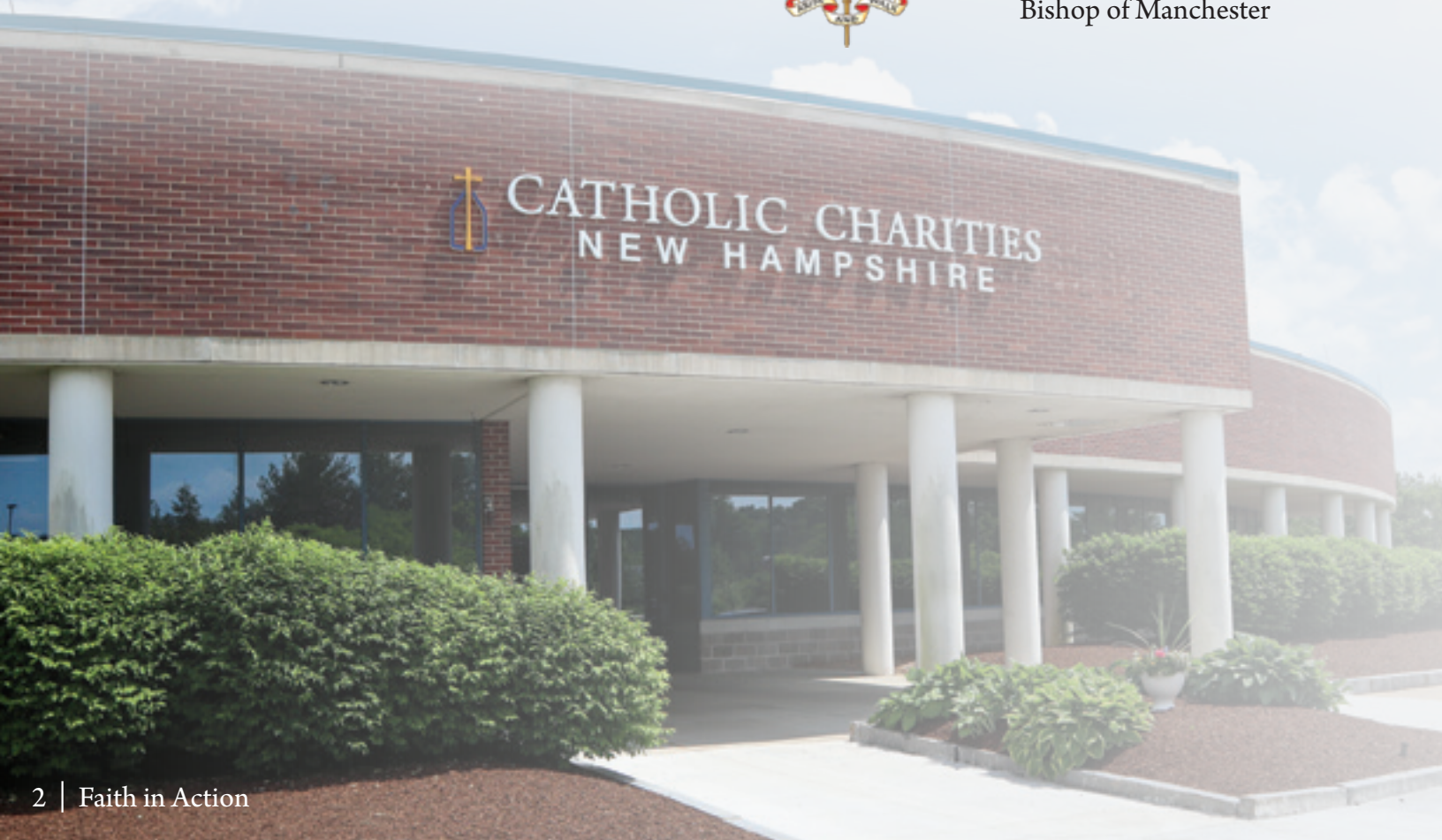

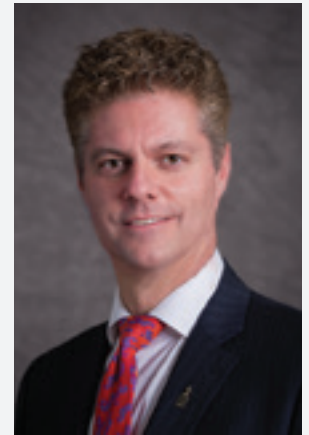

A Veteran’s Footsteps to Freedom

Sheldon walked through the doors of his new employer, standing tall and head held high, proud of how far he’s come.

It was a sharp contrast to a day not too long ago, when he stared defeatedly at his flapping sneaker soles, wondering how he got to what he calls the lowest part of his life. The burden of homelessness, substance misuse, and the haunting memories of a painful past weighed heavily on him, leaving him struggling to get through each day.

That’s the “unforgiving cycle” too many veterans like Sheldon know all too well. After serving our country as a US Army combat engineer, he grappled with the cycles of relapse, lost stability, and the slow unraveling of his marriage.

Like many other veterans, Sheldon’s life changed when he found Liberty House, the Catholic Charities NH program that provides transitional housing and support to help those like him get back on their feet, regain their stability, and try to best put the challenges of their past in the past.

Sheldon worked with Liberty House staff through its unique 4-step program. He focused on his recovery, obtained essential documents and found steady work. Then he moved into an apartment, got a new job at an aerospace company and reconnected with his wife. For the first time in a long time, Sheldon’s feet are planted firmly on solid ground.

Your generosity empowers veterans like Sheldon to rewrite their futures with renewed sense of purpose, resilience and strength for the road ahead.

Stability After Homelessness

As you step into the Second Generation Thrift Shop in Greenland, Abi's warm smile and can-do attitude will likely greet you.

She is newest Thrift Shop Sales Associate at the store that benefits New Generation, the program of Catholic Charities NH that provides emergency shelter – and a new beginning – for single mothers with children, like herself.

Abi's life was difficult from the start, growing up in an abusive environment and later spending two years homeless in Boston before her sister found her and brought her to New Hampshire, hoping it would be the new beginning she needed.

She met someone she thought was the love of her life and became pregnant with her son Noah. What should have been a joyous time was marred by an abusive relationship with Noah's father, echoing the painful experiences of her past. She didn't want her infant son to take the same path she did, even if it meant having nowhere else to turn.

New Generation was her saving grace. With the unwavering support of the staff, she participated in parenting and financial literacy classes, life skills coaching and other support services that promote personal responsibility, nurturing family development and the skills to live independently.

A turning point came when she received the long-awaited phone call. She and Noah were offered an affordable apartment – and for the first time ever, a home they could call their own.

Like many others before her, Abi is the latest former New Generation resident working at the thrift shop, while receiving aftercare services to prevent a recurrence of homelessness and strengthen her path to self-sufficiency.

Thanks to your support, Abi and many other mothers like her have a safe roof over their heads – backed by a village of support putting their difficult pasts behind them, and creating a brighter future for them and their children.

Helping a Woman Become a Mom

The smiles. One-year-old Chelsea’s pure joy will make you melt. For mom, Ruth, there’s a lot more behind that smile, especially when you consider her situation a little over a year ago.

Recently married and pregnant with her first child, Ruth was all alone in Manchester, while her husband worked through the legal process of obtaining a visa to join her in the US from Kenya. Having no personal support system, Ruth became more and more worried as the due date approached.

With two weeks to go, as thoughts of ‘I’ve never done this before’ and ‘how am I going to get through this alone?’ kept circulating through her head, a suggestion from a friend changed everything: “You should call Our Place; they will help you through this. They helped me.”

Ruth reached out immediately and the Our Place staff jumped right in to help her prepare for the birth and let her know what to expect. Within a few days, a healthy baby girl named Chelsea was born – a birth that Ruth called “easy” because everything happened as the staff at Our Place said it would.

A program of Catholic Charities NH, Our Place not only prepares pregnant women for the birth of a child, but also provides parenting education to ensure that babies grow and develop in a nurturing, safe and healthy environment.

As a first-time mother, Ruth has taken full advantage of the parenting program. When she had difficulty breastfeeding, Our Place was there to help her reposition Chelsea so that she could successfully feed her and maintain good nutrition. Her caseworker, Kristen, suggested strategies around napping to help Chelsea sleep better at night, and showed Ruth how to properly install the child seat in her car to keep Chelsea safe. A regular at Our Place group parenting sessions, Ruth has also benefitted from the sharing of experiences among other parents navigating these early childhood years.

So, Ruth’s smile is more than joy – it’s the smile of a competent and confident mom. A smile that was made possible by your support.

Carol's Village of Support

Few things – spending time with her family or diving into a new book – matter more to Carol than her wish to remain living independently in her home.

However, living on oxygen and facing various health challenges, the demands of homeownership have become increasingly overwhelming. Even more, she no longer drives, which makes getting food or getting to her growing number of doctor appointments even more complex.

Carol is one of many seniors across the Monadnock Region that relies on Monadnock at Home, a program of Catholic Charities NH, to better live independently without worrying about the frequent challenges of being a homeowner or living alone. It connects members to various social activities, volunteers and trusted service providers.

Monadnock at Home volunteers have become an essential lifeline for Carol, taking her to appointments

with her pulmonary doctor, cardiologists, and physical therapists. They have also assisted her with everyday home needs, from fixing appliances to setting up a new television so she can indulge in her passion for tennis. Regular check-in calls ensure that everything is going well for her.

The kindness and dedication of the volunteers have deeply touched Carol's heart. She fondly describes them as “the nicest people I've ever met.”

Though Monadnock at Home operates on a subscription model, the affordable membership fee makes it accessible to seniors like her in the area. Generous donor contributions also play a vital role in funding the program and providing scholarships to seniors who may struggle to afford it.

Thanks to our volunteers – and support from people like you – Carol feels incredibly fortunate to have her village of support.

Your Support Created Lasting Impact _____

Through your support over the past year, 25% more New Hampshire residents were assisted through our programs aimed at alleviating poverty, homelessness, isolation, mental health challenges and other significant barriers our communities face. This includes:

Helping Veterans Heal & Regain Stability – Liberty House

- 226 community veterans assisted with food, clothing and basic needs.
- 5,157 collective nights of shelter provided.
- 31% increase in total veterans served.

Building Resilience in the Face of Emotional Pain – Mental Health Counseling

- 2,336 hours of mental health counseling provided.
- 81% of clients reported improvements in their overall quality of life.
- 11% increase in clients served through in-person & teletherapy counseling.

Generating Stability Amid Poverty & Financial Hardship – Community Services

- 3,123 individuals assisted with case management and other support services.
- 2,856 days of habitable housing preserved for individuals and families through electricity assistance.
- 34% increase in individuals and families assisted statewide.

Creating Nurturing Environments for Children – Our Place & New Generation

- 10,353 collective nights of shelter for homeless mothers & children at New Generation.
- 29% increase in mothers and children served through New Generation.
- 98% of Our Place clients noted improvements in their pregnancy and parenting education.
- 130 children positively impacted by the support provided through Our Place.

Helping Seniors Age in Place & Live Independently – CareGivers & Monadnock at Home

- 158,371 pounds of food delivered through CareGivers Caring Cupboard.
- 23,079 miles driven to vital medical appointments and errands through CareGivers Caring Rides.
- 1,107 total member service requests for seniors in the Monadnock Region.
- 83% increase in Monadnock at Home member service requests.
- 29% increase in homebound seniors served through CareGivers Caring Rides.

Welcoming Newcomers – Immigration Legal Services

CareGivers Caring Rides Expands to Lakes Region

Building further upon our wide range of supportive services for seniors statewide, the CareGivers Caring Rides program expanded to the Lakes Region. Seniors residing in Alton and Wolfeboro can now access rides to vital medical appointments, the grocery store and other essential errands.

Caring Rides, the volunteer-driven service of CareGivers, helps homebound and disabled seniors reduce feelings of isolation, increase their sense of independence, and improve their overall physical and emotional well-being.



Mardi Gras Returns, Raising \$200K for Neighbors in Need

Our annual Mardi Gras signature fundraising event made a triumphant return to in-person in 2023, and we truly made up for lost time! Nearly 300 attendees enjoyed a festive evening on February 11 in Manchester to enjoy the unique charm and cuisine from New Orleans as well as plenty of entertainment, a live and silent auction and dancing that lasted well into the night.

Thanks to the generosity of our attendees and sponsors, together, we raised \$200,000 to aid New Hampshire residents in emerging from various forms of hardship and crisis.



CCNH Senior Living Communities Receive National Customer Experience Award

Our seven healthcare service facilities have been nationally honored for their superior customer service as part of the prestigious Pinnacle Quality Insights Awards. The awards were based on feedback from residents and family members, encompassing nursing care, safety and security, communication, and other key service areas. Our seven facilities were the only skilled nursing facilities in New Hampshire that received the honor.



Liberty House Named Progressive Keys to Progress® Recipient

Liberty House, our program serving homeless and struggling veterans, was selected as one of two New Hampshire recipients of the Progressive Insurance Keys to Progress® program. Progressive donated a 2020 Dodge Grand Caravan to provide transportation for residents of the program's substance-free transitional living program, facilitating rides to medical appointments, employment opportunities, and other essential needs.

Our Mission

The Mission of the New Hampshire Food Bank is to feed hungry people by soliciting and effectively distributing grocery products and perishable foods, and offering innovative programs through a statewide network of approved agencies; by advocating for systemic change; and by educating the public about the nature of, and solutions to, problems of hunger in New Hampshire.

7% of NH residents, including children are food insecure.*

8.5% of children in NH are living in food insecure environments.*
